### **The Role: *Senior Quality Assurance Engineer***

The Sr. Quality Assurance Engineer will be very hands on & will serve as a subject matter expert on the development of testing approaches, methodologies, requirements, and creation of performance and regression testing scenarios, frameworks and scripts using automated processes.

- Provide specialized expertise in test automation using commercially available functional test tools including Selenium Webdriver and Cucumber
- Extensive experience with design and development of automation testing frameworks
